

RE: Manufacturing/Dealing Methamphetamine Arrest

On Tuesday March 6, 2012, Sergeant Tim Coomer of the Gibson County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to Lakewood Circle in rural Francisco in reference to a drug investigation. Upon arrival, Sgt. Coomer spoke with the caller and immediately detected a strong chemical odor coming from the garage area of the residence. Upon further investigation, items commonly used to manufacture methamphetamine were discovered and the Indiana State Police lab team was notified.

During the course of the investigation, Sgt. Tim Coomer assisted by several other agencies were able to locate and arrest the suspect, Bryan A Blunck of Francisco. Blunck is currently being held in the Gibson County Jail with no bond, pending initial court appearance this morning and facing frlony charges:

Manufacturing/Dealing Methamphetamine, Neglect of Dependent (Child), Possession of Hypodermic Needles, Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Precursors, and Possession of Paraphernalia. More charges are pending as a result of this multi-law
