The Gibson County Commissioners, EMA, and the Gibson County Sheriff had an emergency meeting reference to flooding in the East Mt. Carmel / Lyles Station area. The Wabash River is to crest at 34.2 feet, which is 1/2 foot over the levee in spots. Gibson County Deputy Sheriff's will be notifying residents in that area of a voluntary evacuation. The Red Cross Emergency Shelter located in the City Building on West State Street in Princeton is open if residents who evacuate need a place to stay.
